Mathematics

Y2:Fractions: recognising a $\frac{1}{4}$, finding a $\frac{1}{4}$, unit fractions, other fractions, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{2}{4}$, finding $\frac{3}{4}$., understanding a whole, understanding whole and parts, counting in halves, counting in quarters.
Position and direction: describing movement, describing turns, making patterns with shapes.
Problem solving and efficient methods: using number facts and equivalence, using 100 square, getting started, missing numbers, mental addition and subtraction, efficient subtraction, solving problems – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
Time: Finding durations of time, comparing durations of time, finding the end time, finding the start time, hours in a day.
Weight, volume and temperature: comparing mass, measuring mass in grams and kilograms, comparing volume in millilitres and litres, measuring temperature using a thermometer, reading thermometers.
