**Mathematics**  
**Numbers to 10** – sorting objects, counting objects, counting backwards, counting 1 more/less, comparing groups, comparing numbers of objects, comparing numbers, ordering objects and numbers, ordinal numbers, the number line.  
**Part-whole within 10** – part-whole model, number bonds, finding number bonds, comparing number bonds  
**Addition and Subtraction within 10** - finding the whole (adding together), adding more, finding a part, finding and making number bonds, finding addition facts, how many are left, breaking apart, related addition and subtraction facts, subtraction by counting back, finding the difference, comparing addition and subtraction, solving word problems  
**2D and 3D shapes** – naming and making patterns  
**Numbers to 20** - counting and writing numbers to 20, tens and ones, counting one more/less, comparing numbers of objects, comparing numbers, comparing objects and numbers.
