Mathematics

Y2: Division: making equal groups, sharing and grouping, dividing by 2, 5 and 10, odd and even numbers, bar modelling – grouping, bar modelling – sharing, solving word problems.
Statistics: making tally charts, creating pictograms interpreting pictograms, block diagrams, solving word problems.
Measurement: Measuring in cm and m, comparing lengths, ordering lengths, solving word problems on length.
Geometry: Recognising 2D and 3D shapes, drawing 2D shapes, counting sides and vertices on 2D shapes, finding lines of symmetry, sorting 2D shapes, making patterns with 2D shapes, counting faces, edges and vertices on 3D shapes, sorting 3D shapes, Making patterns with 3D shapes.
Fractions: introducing whole and parts, making equal parts, recognising and finding a half and a quarter, unit fractions, understanding other fractions, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$, finding $\frac{3}{4}$, understanding a whole and parts, counting in halves and quarters.
